Part 1 - Interpretation

Interpretation

1 In this Act:

"business" means the carrying-on of any commercial activity or industrial undertaking or the provision of any services for the purpose of gain or profit and includes activities carried on by salespersons;

"licence officer" means a person appointed under section 15;

"food preparation business" means a business that has premises where food is prepared or served to the public;

"home occupation" means a business that is carried on in residential premises, where the business use of the premises is secondary to the primary use of the premises as a residence;

"licence" means a business licence;

"licence application" means an application to issue or transfer a licence;

"licence holder" means a person holding a current licence under this Act and includes the principal shareholder or shareholders of a corporation;

"Nisga'a Village" means the village of New Aiyansh;

"Nisga'a Village Government" means the government of the Nisga'a Village of New Aiyansh;

"Nisga'a Village Lands" means Nisga'a Village Lands of the Nisga'a Village;

"premises" means all or any part of any lands or buildings;

"salesperson" means a person who enters Nisga'a Village Lands to

- (a) buy, sell or otherwise deal in goods or services, or
- (b) offer for sale to any person goods or services to be sold at that time or to be delivered or provided later.

Application

This Act applies to all businesses within Nisga'a Village Lands.

Part 2 - Licences

Licence required

3 Every person conducting or carrying on a business within Nisga'a Village Lands must hold a current licence.

Terms and conditions

- A licence officer may impose reasonable terms and conditions on the licence of a business, including
 - (a) the location and hours of operation of the business,
 - (b) the location, size and use of any building of the business, and
 - (c) the number of vehicles which may be used in a home occupation business.

Licence application

- 5 (1) To obtain a licence a person must submit to the licence officer a licence application.
 - (2) A licence application under subsection (1) must be
 - (a) in the form set out in Schedule B,
 - (b) signed by the owner or operator of the business or an authorized agent, and
 - (c) accompanied by the fee required in Schedule C for the type of business licence being applied for.
 - (3) A person applying for a licence for a food preparation business must provide the licence officer with evidence, satisfactory to the licence officer, that the premises comply with the requirements of the B.C. *Health Act* for the operation of the food preparation business.
 - (4) A separate application form and licence fee must be submitted for each business for which a licence is required.

Annual licence fees

6 (1) Every person conducting or carrying on a business must pay to the licence officer the licence fee required in Schedule C for the type of business by January 15 for each calendar year.

- (2) A person who applies for a licence to take effect after June 30 must pay only one-half the fee required in Schedule C.
- (3) A person who surrenders a licence under section 14 before June 30 is entitled to a refund of one-half of the licence fee under Schedule C paid by the person.

Home occupation businesses

- 7 A person must not conduct or carry on a home occupation business that
 - (a) occupies so much of the area of the residential premises that, in the reasonable opinion of the licence officer, it alters the residential character of the premises,
 - (b) adversely affects the traffic or on-street parking of other residences in the vicinity of the residential premises, or
 - (c) creates noise, dust, vibration, odour or any other nuisance.

Obligation of licence holder

8 A licence holder must comply with this Act and any terms and conditions set out in the licence.

Separate licences required

9 Every person conducting or carrying on more than one business within Nisga'a Village Lands must obtain a separate licence for each business.

Licence to be posted

A licence holder must, wherever possible, post its licence in a conspicuous place on the premises from which the business of the licence is conducted or carried out.

Notification where changes affect licence

- 11 (1) A licence holder must, as soon as practicable, notify the licence officer of any change in
 - (a) the holder's mailing or business address,
 - (b) the type of business carried out,
 - (c) the interest or ownership of the holder in the business that is licenced, or
 - (d) the area of the premises in which the business that is licenced is conducted or carried out.

(2) A licence holder must give notice under subsection (1) by submitting, to the licence officer, a licence application, in the form set out in Schedule B, signed by the owner or operator of the business, or an authorized agent.

Licence period

Subject to section 13, the licence officer must issue a licence to be in effect for a calendar year commencing January 1.

Licence periods of less than one year

- On request of an applicant for a licence for a business
 - (a) as a salesperson, or
 - (b) a business that operates on a seasonal or periodic basis,

the licence officer may issue a licence for a period of less than one year.

Termination or transfer of business

A licence holder must, upon termination, sale or transfer of the business for which the licence as issued, notify the licence officer in writing and surrender the licence to the licence officer.

Part 3 - Licence Officers

Licence officer

15 The Nisga'a Village Government will appoint a licence officer.

Granting of licence

- 16 (1) A licence officer must consider a licence application and must grant a licence if the licence officer is satisfied that
 - (a) the person applying has complied with all applicable statutory requirements, including those relating to building, zoning, health, sanitation and business operations,
 - (b) there are an insufficient number of similar businesses in the Nisga'a Village to serve the population, and
 - (c) the business will provide economic and social benefits to the population of the Nisga'a Village.
 - (2) The licence officer must issue a licence in the form set out in Schedule A.
 - (3) A licence officer must, within 5 days of refusing to grant a licence
 - (a) provide a written notice to the person applying stating the reason for the refusal, and
 - (b) return, to the person applying, the licence application fee submitted.

Revocation and suspension of licence

- 17 (1) A licence officer may, by written order, revoke or suspend a licence, if the licence holder
 - (a) has not paid the licence fee required under section 6.
 - (b) has been convicted of an indictable offence in Canada,
 - (c) has been convicted of an offence under any laws in respect of the business or with respect to the business premises named in the licence,
 - (d) in the reasonable opinion of the licence officer
 - (i) has maintained the business premises named in the licence, or

- (ii) has conducted the business
- in a manner that may be harmful or dangerous to the health or safety of any person, or
- (e) has failed to meet the lawful requirements to conduct or carry on the business for which the licence was issued or with respect to the business premises named in the licence.
- (2) A licence officer may impose terms and conditions in suspending a licence under subsection (1).
- (3) Before a licence officer suspends or revokes a licence under subsection (1), the licence officer must
 - (a) give a written notice to the licence holder stating the reason for the order and
 - (b) give the licence holder a reasonable opportunity to make a submission.
- (4) A licence holder must, upon revocation or suspension of a licence, surrender the licence to the licence officer.

Inspection

On the written request of a licence officer, a licence holder must permit the officer to inspect the business premises named in a business licence at any time during reasonable business hours.

Provide information

On the written request of a licence officer, a licence holder must provide to the officer all information reasonably requested by the officer to enable the officer to determine whether this Act is being complied with.

Part 4 - General

Right of Review

20 A person

- (a) whose application has been refused under section 16, or
- (b) whose licence has been revoked or suspended under section 17,

may request a review of that decision under the Nisga'a Administrative Decisions Review Act.

Penalties

A person who contravenes sections 3, 7 to 11, 18 or 19 commits an offence punishable under the Nisga'a Offence Act.

Commencement

This Act comes into force on JANUARY 4, 2001.
